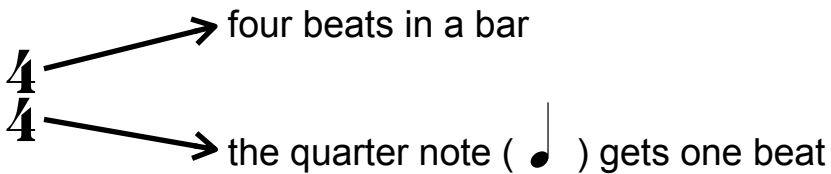


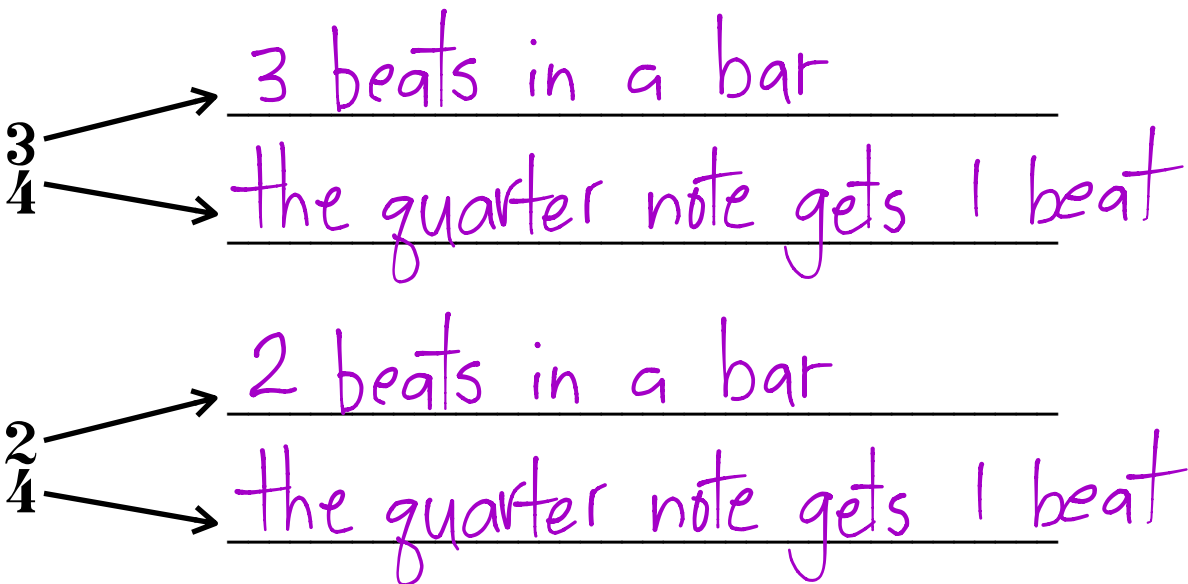


Based on the example above, fill in the definitions for the following time signatures.



NEW NOTE!

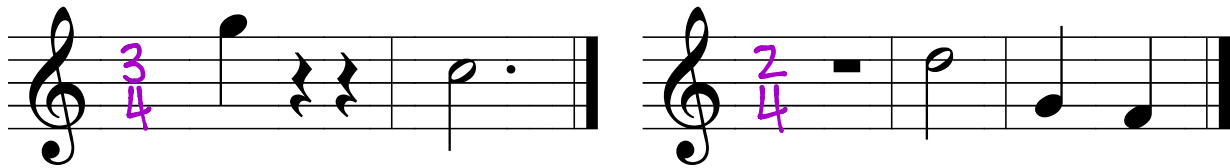
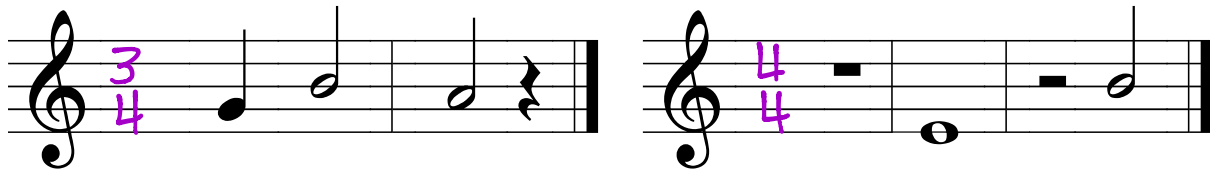
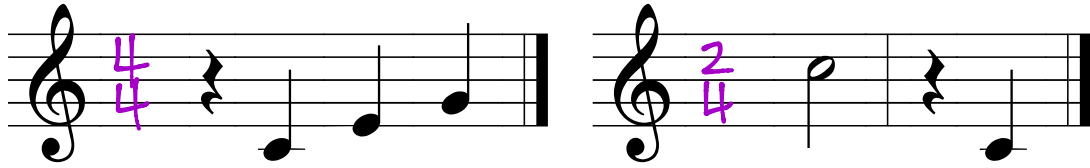
dotted half note  = 3 beats

WHOLE REST (new definition)

A whole rest  fills up a whole bar with silence. That means that it can get 2, 3, or 4 beats depending on the *time signature*.
